The undersigned residents of Alamo Ranch desire to incorporate their community into a municipality according to their right reserved in Article 11 of the Texas Constitution. In order to exercise this right they hereby petition the City Council of San Antonio to allow a vote on the issue of incorporating the community of Alamo Ranch, Texas into a municipality within the extra-territorial jurisdiction of the City of San Antonio by giving its written consent by ordinance or resolution. Attached to this petition is a map of the proposed City of Alamo Ranch which encompasses 8.99 square miles entirely within Bexar County and containing over 2,000 residents.

Alamo Ranch lies in far west Bexar County outside of Loop 1604.

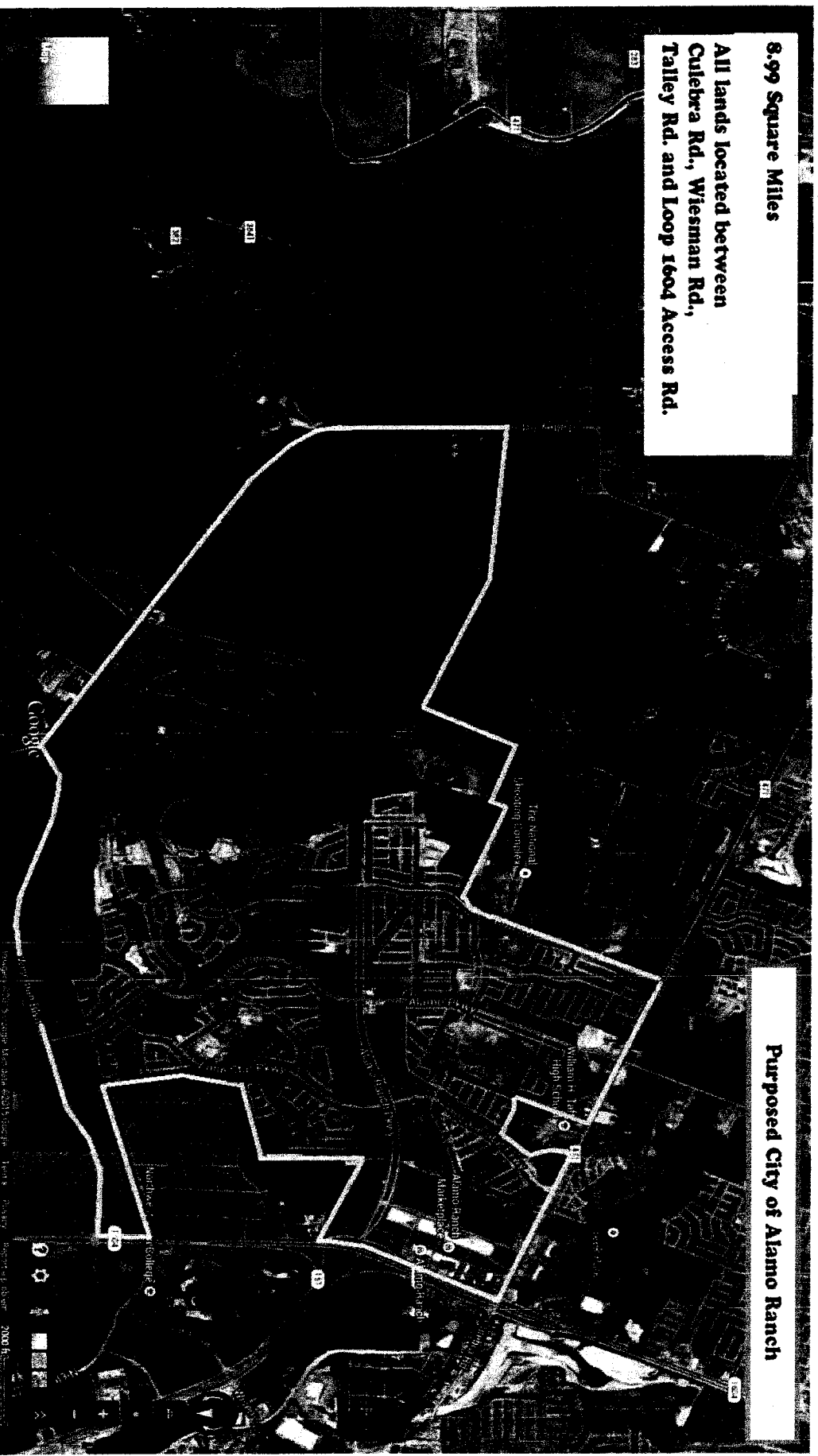


